BILLING POLICY

Residents of the Mt. Washington Fire Protection District provide financial support through the payment of annual taxes. Accordingly, when a resident receives ambulance transport services, Mt. Washington Fire & EMS shall collect only that amount of money which is payable under the resident's insurance policy. The resident shall not have an obligation, such as a co-payment or deductible, to Mt. Washington Fire & EMS, because such payments have been made through the payment of their property taxes to the Mt. Washington Fire Protection District.

Non-Residents have not paid any taxes to Mt. Washington Fire Protection District. Therefore, non-residents who receive ambulance transport services shall be assessed a fee for service and shall be obligated to pay the full amount of the fee including, but not limited to, the amount otherwise covered by an applicable insurance coverage.

Payment of services are due within thirty (30) days unless payment plan arrangements are made. Minimum payment arrangement is \$25.00/month until balance is paid in full. Payment arrangement for outstanding balances shall not exceed twelve (12) months from billing statement date – unless expressly authorized by the Mt. Washington Fire & EMS Board of Directors.

Individuals who have been transported by Mt. Washington Fire & EMS ambulance and did not provide adequate health insurance information, at the time, will receive an inquiry from Mt. Washington Fire & EMS third party billing administrator, 911 Billing, on behalf of the agency. The patient or patient's representative can submit insurance information to 911 Billing at:
